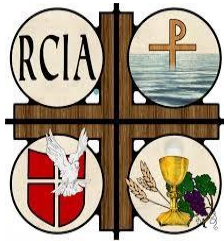

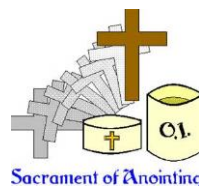

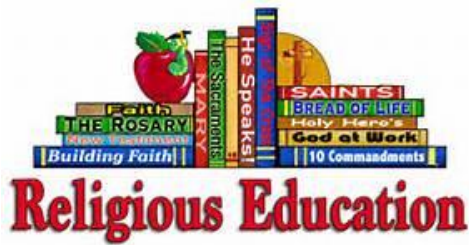

Spanish sessions:

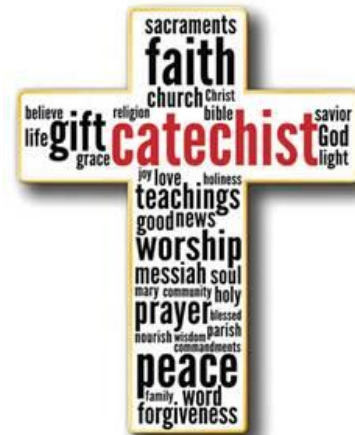

Last school year a majority of parents disregarded the established procedure for dropping off their children before class and picking them up after class. This resulted in a safety issue for everyone in the parking lot. We will emphasize the Drop Off/Pick Up Procedure at the Parent Meetings. The safety of all the students depends on everyone's cooperation with complying with this procedure.

- Parents that choose to disregard this procedure will be given a refund on their child's tuition, and their child will be removed from class.
- If a parent sends a designated adult to pick up their child, it is the parent's responsibility to inform that person of the correct procedure for picking up their children.
