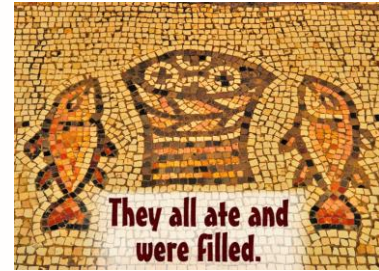

## Ninth Week of Ordinary Time

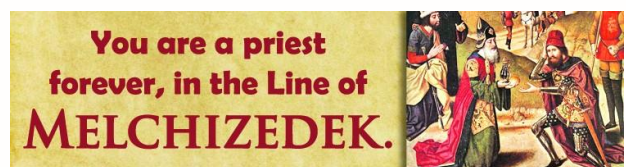


In the US, Sunday is the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**. Luke's gospel is the miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Most of the rest of the world celebrates the **Ninth Sunday of Ordinary Time** and Luke's Gospel tells us about the healing of the Centurion's slave.

Tuesday is the **Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. Wednesday is the **Memorial of Saint Justin, Martyr**. Friday is the **Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** and Saturday is the **Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary**.

The first readings this week are from the pastoral letters, **The Second Letter of Peter** and **The Second Letter to Timothy**.

Mark's Gospel offers stories of how Jesus is in the midst of a struggle with the religious leaders in Jerusalem who do not like them. He tells them the Parable of the tenant farmers, telling them that the stone rejected by builders has become the cornerstone. They almost arrest him. His opponents try to ensnare Jesus with question about the temple tax, but he isn't trapped by them. When they question him about the resurrection, Jesus tells a parable which teaches that God is the God of the living. When asked which is the first commandment, Jesus gives two - highlighting the equal importance of love of God and neighbor. Jesus is both Son of David and Messiah and Lord. Jesus warns of those who abuse widows on spiritual pretexts and tells his disciples to notice the widow who gave from her poverty.

- El día de la Última Cena, refiriéndose al pan que había tomado de la mesa y que acababa de convertir en su cuerpo, Jesucristo dijo: **“Esto es mi cuerpo”**.
- Otro día, refiriéndose a los hambrientos, sedientos, forasteros, enfermos y encarcelados, expresó la misma verdad, solo que con otras palabras: **“cuando lo hicieron con el más insignificante de mis hermanos, conmigo lo hicieron”**.
- “El pan consagrado en el altar es, pues, realmente el cuerpo de Cristo; pero también lo son sus hermanos, puesto que en ellos tiene hambre, sed, frío, soledad, desamparo y tristeza: **“porque estuve hambriento y me dieron de comer...”**”.
- Así, pues, el cuerpo de Cristo que recibimos en la Eucaristía, nos compromete seriamente con el cuerpo de Cristo que son todos sus hermanos.
- Y esto porque, si Cristo nos entrega su cuerpo en la Comunión, a nosotros no nos queda sino entregarnos a él, conde él quiso estar: en los demás.
- Entre otros, en el cónyuge que tiene **hambre** de afecto, de respeto, de ser tratado como igual...
- En los hijos, que quizás están desnudos de cariño, de comprensión, de ser tomados en cuenta...
- En todos los que tienen hambre y están desnudos en el sentido literal de la palabra...

Aquellos que son pobres, oprimidos, indefensos, humillados, ignorantes, minusválidos, y los niños por nacer, también son el cuerpo de Cristo.
